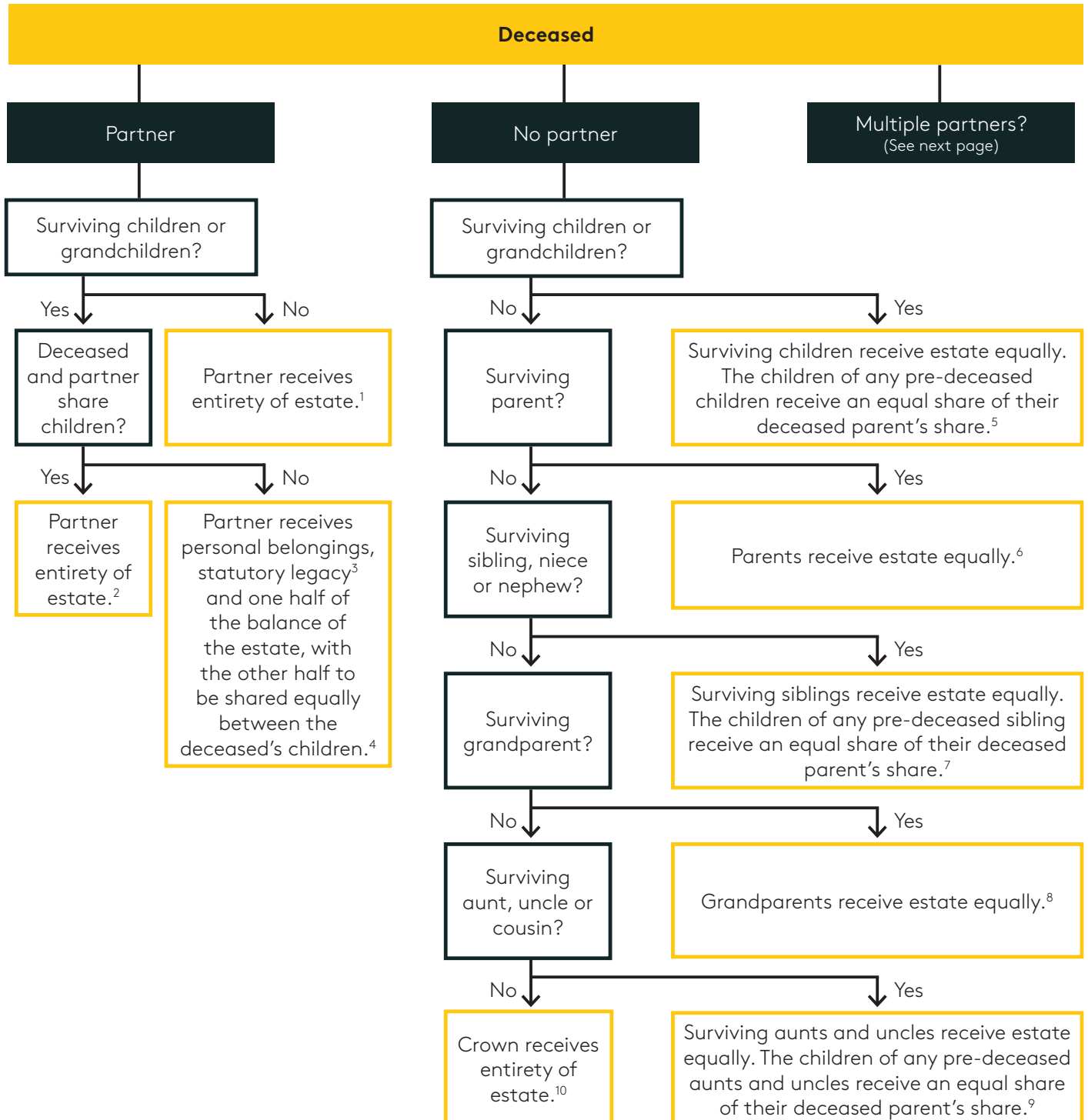
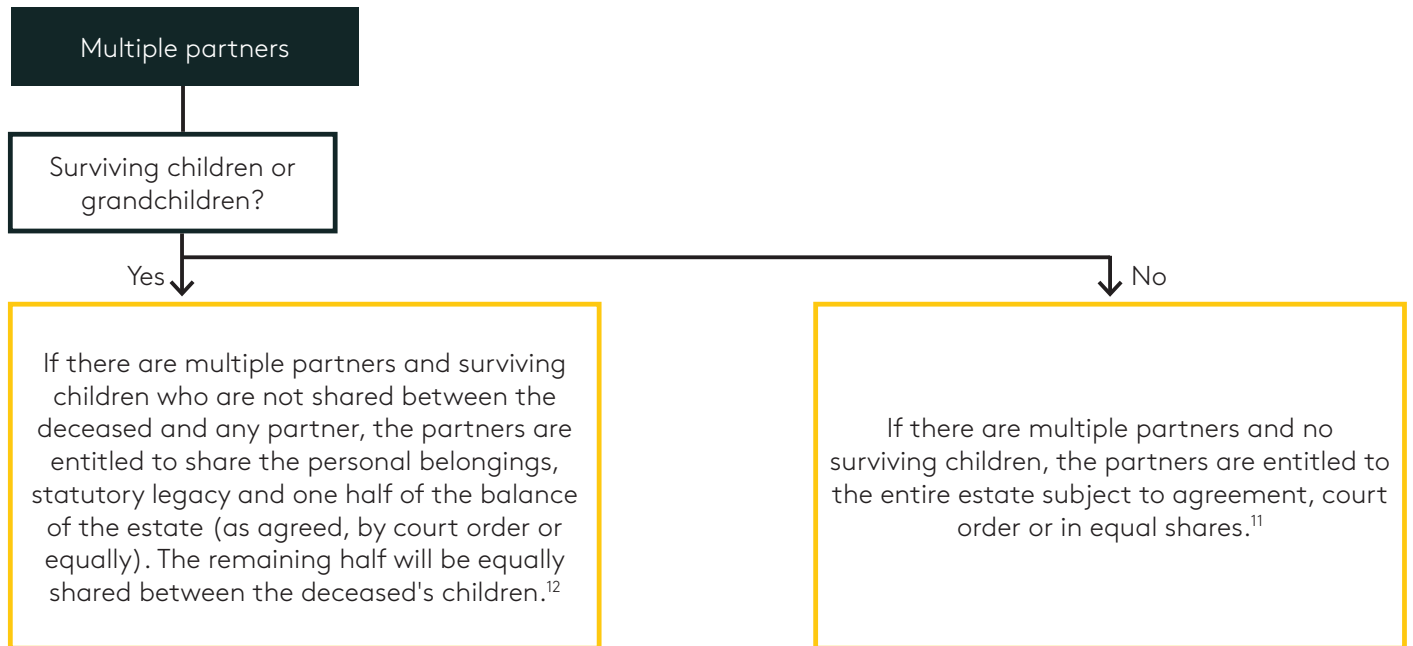


# Guide to Victoria's intestacy laws
